### RESOLUTION TO ADOPT BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE SUMS OF MONEY

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TIMNATH FARMS NORTH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 6, TOWN OF TIMNATH, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, PURSUANT TO SECTION 29-1-108, C.R.S., SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND, ADOPTING A BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY FOR THE BUDGET YEAR 2020

- A. The Board of Directors of Timnath Farms North Metropolitan District No. 6 (the "**District**") has appointed CliftonLarsonAllen LLP to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time.
- B. CliftonLarsonAllen LLP has submitted a proposed budget to this governing body for its consideration.
- C. Upon due and proper notice, published or posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, a public hearing was held on August 20, 2020, and interested taxpayers were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget.
- D. The budget has been prepared to comply with all terms, limitations and exemptions, including, but not limited to, reserve transfers and expenditure exemptions, under Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution ("TABOR") and other laws or obligations which are applicable to or binding upon the District.
- E. Whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.
- F. The Board of Directors has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget.
- G. It is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, thereby establishing a limitation on expenditures for the operations of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TIMNATH FARMS NORTH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 6, TOWN OF TIMNATH, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

- 1. The budget, as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, is hereby approved and adopted as the budget of the District for the year stated above.
- 2. The budget is hereby approved and adopted, shall be certified by the Secretary of the District to all appropriate agencies and is made a part of the public records of the District.

## TIMNATH FARMS NORTH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 6 2020 BUDGET SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ASSUMPTIONS

#### Services Provided

The District was formed on August 20, 2020, to provide for the design, acquisition, construction, installation and financing of certain street, park and recreation, water, sanitation, mosquito control and safety protection improvements and services. The District was organized in conjunction with Timnath Farms North Nos. 4 and 5. On September 10, 2019, the service plan for Timnath Farms North Nos. 1-3 was amended and restated to include Districts Nos. 4-6.

The District has no employees and all administrative functions are contracted.

The District prepares its budget on the modified accrual basis of accounting in accordance with the requirements of Colorado Revised Statutes C.R.S. 29-1-105 using its best estimates as of the date of the budget hearing. These estimates are based on expected conditions and its expected course of actions. The assumptions disclosed herein are those that the District believes are significant to the budget. There will usually be differences between the budget and actual results, because events and circumstances frequently do not occur as expected, and those differences may be material.

#### Revenues

The District anticipates no revenues in 2020.

### **Expenditures**

The District anticipates no expenditures in 2020.

### **Debt and Leases**

The District has no outstanding indebtedness, nor any operating or capital leases.

### Reserves

### **Emergency Reserve**

The District has not provided for an Emergency Reserve equal to at least 3% of fiscal year spending, as there are no expenditures anticipated in 2020.
